1. LIST OF DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

The signed and stamped copies of following documents should be submitted as part of the technical/commercial bid submission.

- a. Power of Attorney authorizing the person who has signed the tender to act and sign on behalf of the company.
- b. Certificate of registration/incorporation in the case of Pvt Ltd/Public Ltd Company /certified copy of / partnership deed in the case of LLP/Partnership firm/ any document under the relevant rules/laws if the firm is a proprietorship firm.
- c. Income Tax PAN Number.

- e. Valid PF and ESI Registration No.
- f. Chartered accountant's certificate or Audited / Certified Balance sheet and Profit and Loss account of tenderer's company for last three years ending 31.03.2019

2. VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS / SUBMISSION OF BIDS / CANCELLATION OF BIDS

- a. If VPLPL wants to verify all the submitted documents, then the bidder should bring all original documents.
- b. Failure on part of the tenderer to report on specified date and time for paper verification may result in rejection of the tender submitted by them without further communication.
- c. Tenderer should be in a position to produce all the original documents and/or any other information on dates as intimated or as and when required by VPLPL.
- d. Incomplete Tenders are liable for rejection without any reference to the tenderer and decision of VPLPL in this respect will be final.
- e. If at any stage it transpires that any party submitted false or forged documents may be Blacklisted and the contract could be cancelled, criminal prosecution or any other action as deemed fit may be initiated.
- f. VPLPL reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons whatsoever.
- g. Bids of any tenderer may be rejected if a conflict of interest between the bidder and Company (VPLPL) is detected at any stage.
- h. All the bids will be evaluated based on the criteria as mentioned in this NIT. Tenders of those bidders who are not meeting the criteria as specified in the NIT, shall not be considered for commercial evaluation.

4. Special Note

- a. VPLPL will not be responsible for any delay under any circumstances for non-receipt of any documents sent by post as part of response to the tender. Bidders are requested to provide correct "e-Mail address" and "Mobile No." for receiving updates related to tender from time to time.
- b. The bidder has to keep track of any changes by viewing the Addendum/Corrigendum issued by the Tender Inviting Authority on time-to-time basis in the Balmer Lawrie website. The Company calling for tenders shall not be responsible for any claims/problems arising out of this.

5. Filling of Tender Documents

- a. The tenderers are requested to carefully study all the tender documents and tender conditions before quoting their rates.
- b. The tender must be strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions and specifications laid out in the tender.
- c. Any terms and conditions given by the tenderer in their offers will not be binding on VPLPL.
- d. The sole proprietor or authorised representative shall sign all documents that needs to be submitted. When the person signing the documents is not the sole proprietor / authorised representative of the company, the Power of Attorney authorizing such person to act and sign on behalf of the company must be submitted and produced later on for verification by VPLPL.
- e. Bidder has to fill the relevant details in the submitted price bid schedule.

SCOPE OF WORK

Concise Scope of Work:

1.1) Supply and Application of Paints for Pipelines and Tanks with one coat paint primer and two coats of Finnish paints with Enamel paints make Asian/Berger of Specified Colour with thorough cleaning of all foreign material, rust on the surface including cost of conveyance of all materials, machinery, scaffolding, labour charges etc, complete as specified by the engineer in charge. (As per list enclosed as **Annexure 4**)

1.2) Supply and application of paints for Structural Steel members, with one coat primer and two coats of Finnish paints with Enamel paints like Asian / Berger of specified colour with through cleaning of all foreign material, rust on the surface including cost of conveyance of all materials, machinery, scaffolding, labour charger etc., complete as specified by Engineer-IN-Charge. . (As per list enclosed as **Annexure 4**)

Detailed Scope of Work:

- 2.1 The scope of work broadly consists of painting of pipeline and structural steel work. **ANNEXURE 3** contains pictures of the pipeline/steel system to show the rusting issues to be rectified. The work shall consist of surface preparation as required, selection and application of required paints on surface of piping ducts, steel structures etc. including but not limited to the followings :
 - 2.1.1 All structural steel work including pipe rack, walkways on platform, handrails, pipe supports, ladders etc. as per specification and instructions of EIC.
 - 2.1.2 All un insulated piping and all fittings including flanges and valves (Including providing identification marks).
 - 2.1.3 Outer surface and nozzles including fittings of vessels (Including providing identification marks).
 - 2.1.4 Any other surface as directed by Engineer-in-Charge including all surfaces.
 - 2.1.5 Painting identification, colour bands on all painted surface of piping.
 - 2.1.6 Identification lettering/ numbering on all painted surface of piping.
 - 2.1.7 Cleaning up the working areas regularly during the course of work for purpose of good house keeping as well as cleaning up the site on completion of the work as directed by Engineer-in-charge.
 - 2.1.8 Painting means complete preparation of surface by cleaning by wire brushing, applying primer as per specification, applying finish paint as per specification.

**2.2 INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED WHILE DOING PAINTING JOBS AT HEIGHT:
(IF APPLICABLE)**

2.2.1 The work is to be carried out restoring the special arrangement & safety precautions as indicated below:

- a. The scaffolding shall be provided upto top of the job and a safety net should be maintained at a suitable distance below the scaffold/temporary platform. Under the working floor of the scaffolding, the next lower floor should be left in position as a catch platform.
- b. Additional safety measures like providing Fall Arrestor type safety belt, Lifeline etc. shall be provided wherever required.
- c. Work on height should not be carried on in high winds, icy conditions, fog or during electrical storms.

2.2.2 In no case, work shall be carried out without the arrangement & safety precautions as indicated above.

2.2.3 The specification of the paint for the work is indicated as follows:

PAINT MATERIALS:-

Manufacturers shall furnish the characteristics of all paints indicating the suitability for the required service conditions. Primer and finish coats shall be of class - I quality and shall conform to the following:-

Manufacturers shall furnish the characteristics of all paints indicating the suitability for the paint system for a period of **Three years** for the prevailing environment in Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.

3.0 CONTRACTOR'S SCOPE OF SUPPLY:-

- d. All general purpose tools, non sparking tools and tackles suitable for required for the job shall be supplied by contractor.
- e. All personnel protective equipment's applicable in the plant are to be supplied by the contractor to the persons deployed at site. Contractor must provide to their working personnel safety appliances like helmet, safety shoes, welding goggles, safety belts, cotton and asbestos hand gloves etc.
- f. Contractor has to provide and keep the required materials at site as per EIC.
- g. All primers and paints as per specifications.
- h. Synthetic Enamel Paint etc. for colour coding for identification purpose.
- i. Steel scaffolding with proper clamps wherever required.
- j. Safety Net of approved quality to be provided below the working platform made from steel scaffolding for height jobs if applicable.
- k. All Consumables, painting brush, wire brush and any other material to complete the job in all respects including safe storage of paints.
- l. Special protection, if any, required for performing work during adverse weather conditions as well as for avoiding deteriorations/ damage of the coated surfaces until dry and ready for use, protection of surrounding equipments, structures etc. during the course of work and any other precautions as may be directed by the Engineer-in-charge.
- m. All other materials not mentioned above, but covered in relevant Standards/ drawings and Technical specifications, and required to complete the work in all respects.

4.0 OWNER'S SCOPE OF SUPPLY:-

- 4.1 No materials other than as stated in 4.2 will be supplied by the owner.
- 4.2 Electricity, and water for plant purpose shall be given free of cost by VPLPL at one point.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Eligibility Criteria For Techno-Commercial Bid

- d. In view of the pandemic and slowdown in economy, instead of EMD, bidders should submit "Bid Security Declaration" as found in Annexure 2, duly signed by bidder.
- e. Should have minimum average turnover of Rs.5 Lacs during the last 3 years ending March 2020 or latest. Copy of audited Profit/Loss Account and Balance sheet to be attached.
- f. Bidder should have experience in providing similar services of painting machinery in any commercial establishment with similar systems in at least three projects. The bidder should submit copies of work orders or agreement and completion certificate in support of the same. Work orders without corresponding completion / part-completion certificates will not be considered. Applicants with work experience of Govt./PSU organisations will be preferred, but such experience is not mandatory.
- g. Should not have been blacklisted by any PSU / Govt. Department (a self-certification is required to be submitted by the bidder).
- h. Should have GST Registration number, copy of certificate is to be submitted.

2. Tender Opening

- a. Unpriced and price bid will be opened as per tender calendar.

3. Acceptance of offers

- a. VPLPL reserves the right to accept any tender in whole or in part or reject any tender or all tenders or place order for any quantity, less than or more than the tendered quantity, without assigning any reason thereof.
- b. Bids of any tenderer may be rejected if a conflict of interest is detected between the bidders and VPLPL at any stage.
- c. VPLPL reserves the right to accept the lowest rate for the tender. If the 2 bidders has quoted with the same rate and both became L1 then the bidder having higher average turnover for the last three years will be considered as L1 and further process can be initiated.

- d. VPLPL also reserves its right to allow Public Enterprises (Central / State) price / purchase / contract / service preference as admissible under the existing Government policy. The decision of VPLPL in this connection will be final.
- e. Incomplete tenders, conditional tenders, tenders received late or tender not conforming to the terms and conditions mentioned in the Tender documents or not accompanied by the requisite Earnest Money Deposit (unless exempted under the terms of this Tender) will be rejected.

4. **Negotiations**

- a. VPLPL reserves the right to negotiate with the L1 Bidder. The L1 bidder will have to attend the concerned office of VPLPL for negotiations/clarifications required from them, in respect of their quotations, without any commitment on the part of VPLPL.
- b. In case of negotiation, the Tenderer should send the confirmation of outcome of such negotiation in writing so as to reach the concerned office of VPLPL within 3 days from the date of negotiation/ the time stipulated. If the Tenderer fails to comply with this requirement VPLPL reserves its right to ignore their quotation at its discretion.

5. **Contract Period**

The completion period is 25 days from the date of issue of LOI or W.O. whichever is earlier.

6. **Factory Visit**

The bidder, at the bidder's own cost/responsibility is advised to visit and examine the type of Work and handling conditions etc., and obtain all information and satisfy themselves that may be necessary for preparation and quoting the Tender.

7. **Validity of Offer**

Your offer should be valid for acceptance for 120 days from the date of opening Technical Bid.

8. **Mobilization**

The successful bidder shall be required to mobilize the necessary manpower and others within 3 days after notification by VPLPL, a formal communication to that effect shall be given by an authorized person from VPLPL.

9. **Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)**

In view of the pandemic and slowdown in economy, instead of EMD, bidders should submit "Bid Security Declaration" as found in Annexure 2, duly signed by bidder.

10. **Payment Terms**

Payment will be made in 15 (fifteen) working days after receipt of the invoice in the accounts department duly certified by company officials with all relevant supporting documents. Payment will be cleared only after thorough inspection and approval by VPLPL personnel.

11. **Sub-letting of Work**

No part of the contract or any share or interest therein shall in any manner or degree be transferred, assigned or sublet by the contractor directly or indirectly to any person, firm or corporation without the consent in writing from VPLPL. In the event of contractor flouting the conditions, VPLPL shall be entitled to get the supply from any other firm at the 'Risk & Cost' of the contractor.

12. **Alternative Arrangement**

In the absence of timely and proper performance, i.e. target vs achievement by the Contractor, VPLPL reserves the right to utilize the services of any other Contractor without notice at the risk and cost of the Contractor and to recover charges and expenses in excess of the contractual terms from the Contractor. Similarly if the contractor fails to meet their contractual obligations, the work shall be completed at their risk and cost through alternative sources / arrangements. This will be without prejudice to the rights of VPLPL for any other action including termination, encashment of Bank Guarantee (if applicable) etc.

This contract also does not restrict the right of VPLPL to take recourse to the above conditions even if notice of termination is not served and contract terminated with the Contractor.

13. Addition/alteration of Tender Document

The Company reserves the right to add/alter terms and conditions of tender documents including cancellation of the tender at any time without assigning any reason whatsoever. The Company also reserves the right to accept/reject a tender without assigning any reasons.

14. Termination of Contract.

The contract can be terminated by either party by giving 1 weeks clear notice in writing. However in case of serious breach of contract by the supplier the Company reserves the right to terminate the contract forthwith without notice.

15. Force Majeure Conditions:

If at any time during the continuance of this contract, the performance in whole or part by either party of any obligation under this contract shall be prevented or delayed by reasons of any war, hostility, acts of public enemy, civil commotion sabotage, fire, floods, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, lock outs or acts of God (hereinafter referred as "events") provided notice of the happening of any such events is given by either party to the other within twenty one days from the date of occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reasons of such event, be entitled to terminate this contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance or delay in performance. Deliveries under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable.

16. Liability

The bidder would be fully responsible to ensure safety of lives, goods, vehicles, property within VPLPL premises. Any damage to life or property inside VPLPL due to negligence by the contractor's workmen would be to the account of the contractor and same cost will be debited to contractor.

17. Safety to Company's Property

The contractor should ensure that during the time of job execution there is no damage to the property, personnel of the company. In the event of such damage

same will be repaired / compensated to the company at the cost of the contractor. Any damage to any life and/or property inside the unit due to negligence/mishandling by contractor appointed staff and /or malfunctioning of the machinery due to similar reasons would be to the account of the contractor.

18. Acceptance of Tender

The company reserves the right to accept or reject the offer in part or in full without assigning any reasons whatsoever and /Or to negotiate with tenderer(s) in the manner it considers suitable.

19. Indemnity

The contractor shall indemnify the company, for any financial or other losses that result to the company during the operation of the contract over the actions/inactions on the part of the contractor, which has resulted in the liability of the company. In other words, the contractor shall continue to be responsible to the company in respect of any act of omissions/commissions performed during the tenure of the contract, even though the action may actually be initiated by an external agency or an individual or a statutory authority etc. much after the contract period had expired. The contractor shall be responsible for the acts of omissions and commissions that have taken place during the contract period. An indemnity bond is to be submitted by the contractor before awarding of the contract.

20. Arbitration

Any dispute or difference arising under this Contract shall be referred under jurisdiction of Kolkata to a sole arbitrator appointed mutually under the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 including any statutory modifications or enactment thereof shall apply to the Arbitration proceedings. The fees of the arbitrator, if any, shall be shared equally by both the parties. The award shall be a speaking award stating reason therefor and is final and binding on the parties. The proceeding shall be conducted in English language and courts at Kolkata will have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute arising out of this contract.

21. Purchase preference policy for MSE Vendors

If it is seen that a Micro and Small Enterprises (MSE) has participated and the price quoted by them is within a price band of +15% of the L1 price (which is from a supplier who is not MSME), then such MSE vendor shall be allowed to supply a pre-determined portion of the tendered quantity subject to their matching the L1 price. In case, more than one number of MSE vendors are within the range of L1+15%, all of them shall be given the option of matching the L1 price. In such a situation, the pre-determined quantity shall be equally divided amongst all such MSME vendors who have matched the L1 price. In case the total tender value is not split able, 100% of the value will be given to MSE (within 15% band with non MSE vender) vender subject to matching with L1 price of non MSE vender.

26. Compliance of GST

The vendor should compulsorily follow all the provisions of GST and in the event any default for fulfilling any provisions of the GST Act, Balmer Lawrie & Co. Ltd. would exercise the right for non-payment/withholding payment, / black listing the vendor.

27. TDS Compliance :Central Government vide Notification No.50/2018 dated 13th September 2018, has made TDS provision applicable under GST Law on all payments affected by Public Sector Undertaking (PSU) w.e.f 1st October 2018.

BALMER LAWRIE being a PSU these provisions will be applicable for all the payments made by BALMER LAWRIE on or after 1st October 2018. TDS shall be deducted @ 2% of taxable value excluding GST.

TDS deducted from your payments will be deposited with GST authorities by 10th of the following month and TDS certificates will be issued subsequently.

Kindly note that this TDS under GST Act shall be deducted on both material as well as services. Further this TDS under GST Act is in addition to the TDS as applicable under Income Tax Act, 1961.

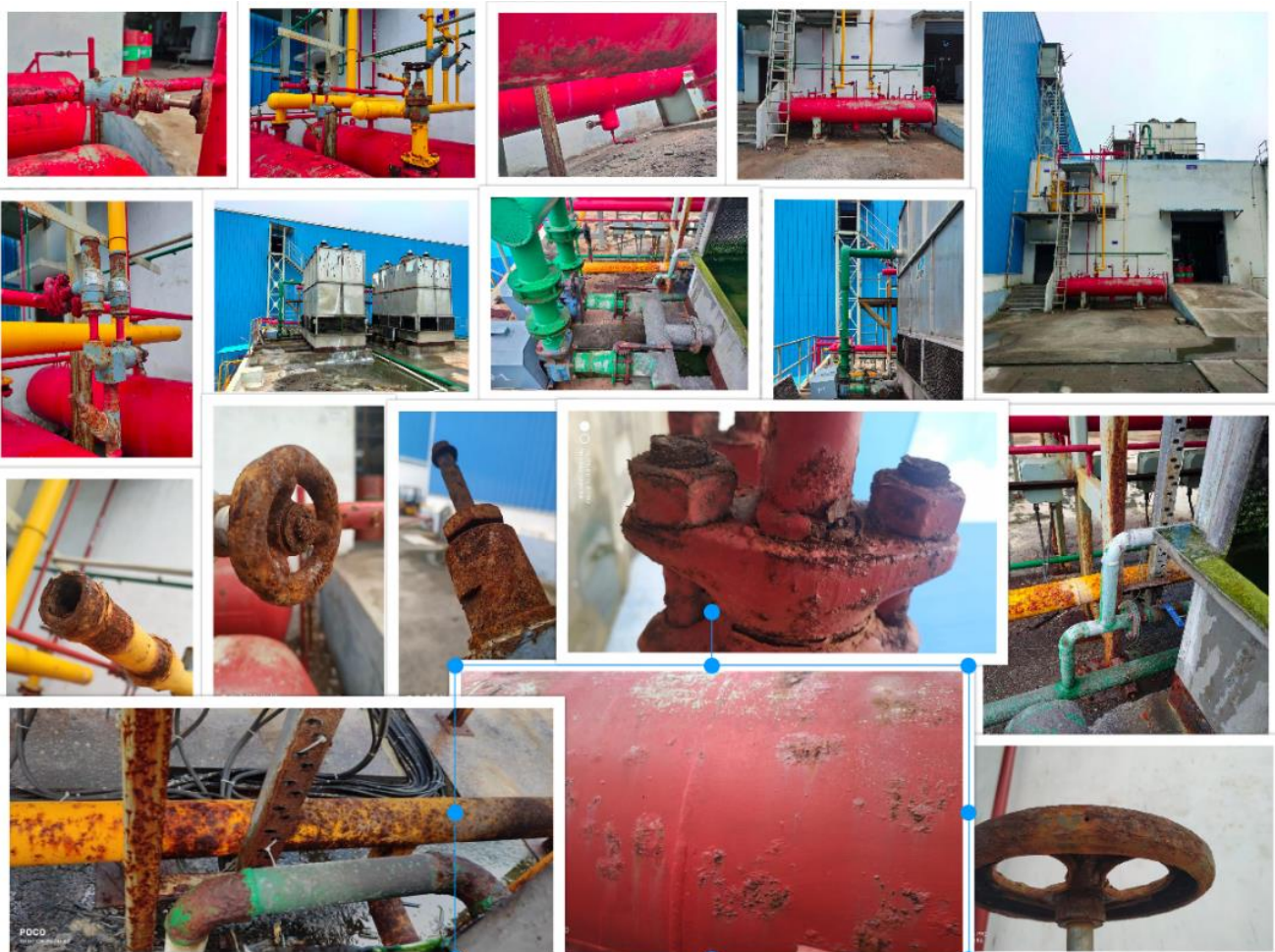
